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<p>Memory verse of the term I am the way the truth and the life, no one comes to the father except through me. John 14:6</p>	<p>Bible story of the term Zaccheus Luke 19 v 1-10 Godly play box</p>	<p>What does it mean? Christian's believe that truth is revealed in the bible and supremely in the person and life of Jesus Christ. Truth is important to Christians. It is seen as a characteristic of God. Being truthful is seen as respecting God and obeying the commandments (Do not give false witness/lie) Christians believe Jesus spoke the truth and that he was the perfect role model on earth.</p>		
<p>Classroom links Why do I sometimes tell a lie? Why do I sometimes exaggerate the truth? Am I always honest with myself? Do I make an honest friend? Who do I trust always to be honest with me?</p>	<p>Links to the Trinity <u>God the Father</u>- God's whole being is based on truth. He gave the 10 commandments including 'do not lie' <u>God the Son</u>- Jesus said he was the truth- he was always honest and truthful- how can this be our role model? <u>God the Spirit</u>- The holy spirit helps us to be truthful. The bible describes the Spirit as helping us put on our armour of God (Ephesians 6- including the belt of truth)</p>	<p>Key concepts It takes courage to be honest. It's much easier to exaggerate, pretend and put on a false front in order to be liked and respected. However, if we build our lives on a lie, the truth often comes out in the end and then the fall-out can be terrible. People respect those whom they can trust, those who are honest. Honesty suggests that nothing is being hidden, which means what you see is what you get. An honest friend will tell the truth and this builds up the friendship.</p>
