Dear Parents and Carers.

We would like to take this opportunity to present you with the information for our 'Year Ahead' in Class 6M and 6F. We are looking forward to working alongside you to nurture and support your child through the academic year.

Year 6 Recommended Homework:

Individual book to be read at home at least 3 x a week and recorded in reading diary. Please can parents ensure they sign to show their child has read? This supports a reading incentive we use in class.

Weekly spellings – Year 6 common exception words and focused words. Times Tables – **Ensure there is rapid recall of all multiplication and division facts.** All children have individual log ins for TT rockstars which is a X table programme they are familiar with using in school.

IXL – this is a digital homework source which your children have individual log ins for. These log ins are recorded in their reading records. Teachers will monitor the engagement for both the maths and the Grammar elements of this programme. This is accessible on laptops, tablets and phones. Any problems, please contact your class teacher.

PE – 6M and 6F (Tuesday afternoon)

Pupils need to have a white t-shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls for indoor PE.

Outdoor PE: joggers, white t-shirt, sweatshirt and trainers

We ask that children come into school on their P.E. day wearing their P.E. kit. They can wear this all day. Please ensure no ear-rings or jewellery.
