Year 5	Additional Information								
<p>Recommended Homework: Each week, we ask children to complete 30 minutes homework on IXL. Each child has their own login and can choose on focus on English or Maths.</p> <p>Weekly spellings – These will change weekly according to their target spellings. These will be given to children on a Monday for them to practise at home.</p> <p>Reading – Children should be reading for at least 30 minutes a week outside of school. It is still important to listen to your child read if possible and note in their reading record when they read at home.</p>	<p>Please send your child to school with a water bottle. Any bottle is acceptable but please write your child's name on them. Children are not allowed juice or fizzy drinks in school.</p> 								
<p>PE – Wednesday afternoons Pupils need to have a white t-shirt, black shorts or tracksuit bottoms and black plimsolls/trainers for PE.</p> <p>Outdoor PE: joggers, sweatshirt and trainers Year 5 will be going swimming this year on alternative terms. We may have the opportunity to swim in term 3 and 4 but this is still to be confirmed.</p> <p>5M will swim terms 1 and 5. 5T will swim terms 2 and 6. Swim kit: swimming attire, a towel and swim cap (preference only)</p> <p>Please remember, children should come to school in their PE kit on Wednesdays on terms where they are not swimming. Additional clothing, eg sports trousers and jumper, should be worn as appropriate.</p> 	<p>Children are encouraged to bring in healthy snacks for breaktime so ask that children do not bring crisps or chocolate as their breaktime snack.</p>  <p>Please ensure that all children's clothing is named to ensure if it gets lost, it can be returned to its owner.</p>
