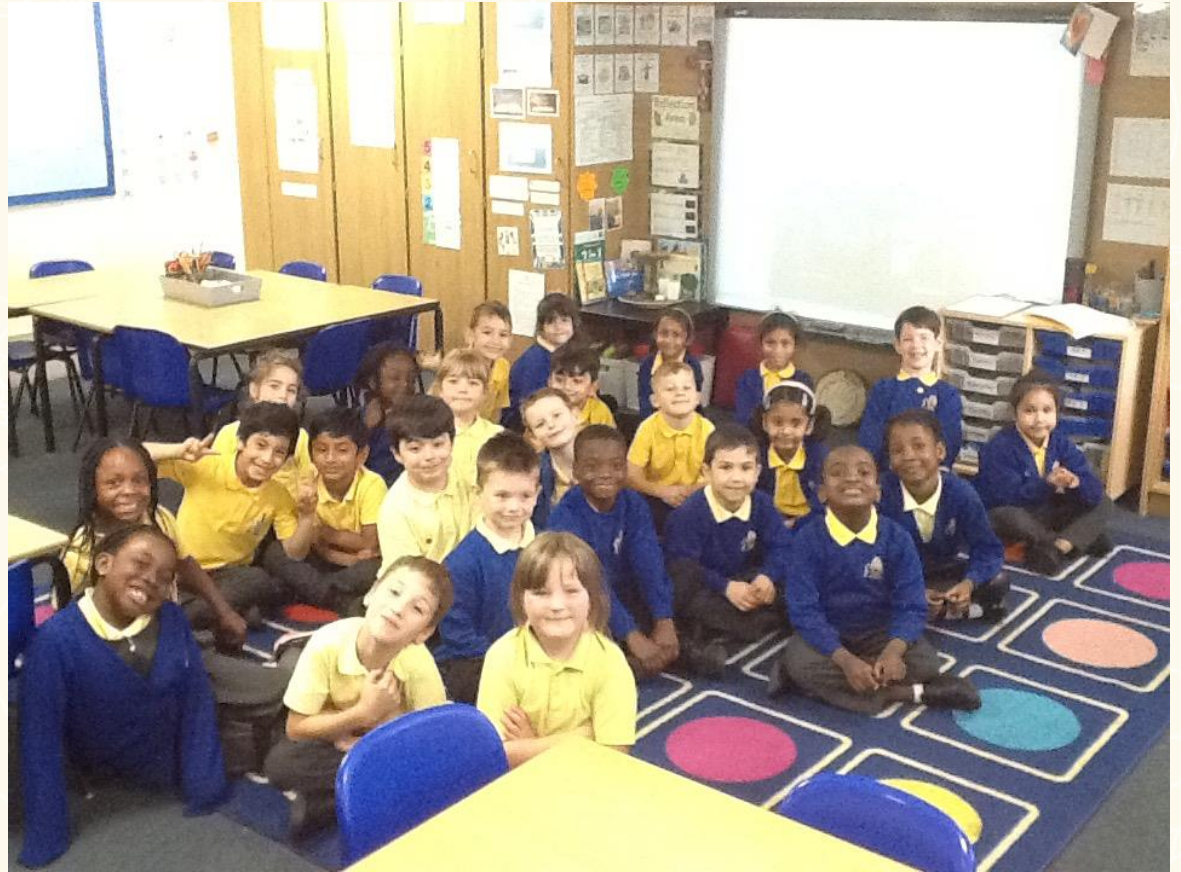
We are in Year 2 so we are either 6 or 7 years old.
